LOCATION OF THE INSTITUTE

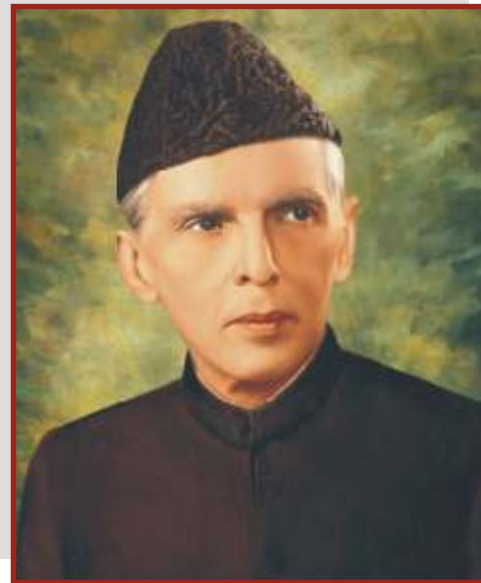

ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR (DPT)

Degree Program	Eligibility
DOCTOR OF PHYSICAL THERAPY/PHYSIOTHERAPY (DPT)	HSC (Pre Medical, 60% minimum marks OR A level (equivalence) SAT-II (550 minimum: biology & chemistry any science subject) & TOFEL (500 or equivalent and IELTS (5.5), if subject are taught in other than English.

ADMISSION POLICY:

Admission will be on merit basis and short listed candidates in entry test will be interviewed by the committee for the final selection. The students waiting for HSC/A level results can also appear in entry test but they will be granted provisional admission upon selection and their admission will stand cancelled automatically if the students fail to attain the required minimum qualification with minimum 60% in intermediate for (DPT).



ADMISSION POLICY / RULES OF ADMISSION

1. The candidates according to will be selected from the merit list of the candidates.
2. The seat vacant by the candidate will be filled-in by next the candidate on merit list.
3. The selected candidate has to deposit fees, all required documents (in original) and join within Seven (07) days after the selection in DPT, in case of failure the selection of candidate shall be cancelled and the Vacant Seat will be offered to next available candidate on waiting list, any seat falling vacant after closing of admission will not be filled and shall stand forfeited.
4. Candidate's admission will be cancelled (from the list of enrolled in LUMHS after joining the Al Biruni institute of Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation Sciences if he/she remains absent for thirty days or more, without any information to the competent authority.
5. Application along with attested photocopies of required documents shall be submitted in the prescribed printed form and all columns must be filled in correctly. Incomplete forms are liable to be rejected.
6. All admissions are provisional, subject to verification of their original documents submitted by the candidate. If, at any stage it is proved that the candidate has been admitted on the basis of FAKE or INCORRECT document(s), her/his admission will be cancelled and University authorities reserve the right to take legal action against that candidate.
7. Selected candidates shall have to pledge through a signed affidavit that they will complete the DPT degree (05 years) program. However, in case, if he/she leaves the program without having any sound justification and/or without any information, student will have to pay an amount of (Rs. 100,000 for merit student and (as a compensation of wasting another desired candidate's seat).
8. If he candidate selected for DPT and paid fees 1st Year 1st Semester and failure/absent in semester fees will be charge.
9. If candidate remain absent one year without information pay full fees he/she cannot claim for not paid the fees after decorrelation of fees with no dues certificate he/she can received original documents.

DOCTOR OF PHYSICAL THERAPY (DPT)

The physical therapy which is also known as physiotherapy due to its dynamic nature of profession and is concerned with rehabilitation of patients visiting to OPD or admitted in hospital for treatment of their disability related to pain, disease or injury through physical therapeutic measures.

The disability ranges from orthopedic problems to cardio-pulmonary, neurological, prosthetic & orthotics, where application of physical therapy plays a dynamic role to restore health back to normal.

This is five year undergraduate full time study program. There are two semesters in each year and duration of each semester will be 18 weeks. The concepts related to the Basic Medical Sciences, Communication Skills and Basic Physiotherapy will be covered in first two years and last three years will deal with Clinical Medical Sciences along with practical physical therapy applications at Bone Care Trauma Center Hospital & Al-Biruni Institute of Physiotherapy & Rehabilitation Sciences.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Application for admission must be submitted on the prescribed form enclosed with this prospectus. Photocopy or computer print out of the form will not be accepted. However, international students applying from outside Pakistan may print out the admission form the website. Incomplete applications in any respect will not be considered.

Attested copies of the following certificates and testimonials should be submitted with the application form:

The applications for admission should reach the Admission office on or before the specified date.

- The written test will be taken and for that sample test paper is available which will be provided to the students who will complete the requirements of application form and register for admission test. The prospectus and application forms are available at campus.
- The test will be conducted at building of Al-Biruni Institute of Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation Sciences. The schedule for conducting the test will be communicated through announcement in Media and Posts or Emails submitted at the time of registration.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Students are expected to exhibit and observe generally standards of the high quality conduct. The college reserves the right to expel any student whose conduct is injurious in any manner to the college. Rules and regulations for students policy decisions pertaining to student's promotion are based on laid down rules and regulations approved by the governing body of the college. A printed booklet on the approved rules and regulations on student promotion is provided to students should not expect any waiver of rules on individual basis. The college reserves the right to amend rules and regulations as and when required.

POLICY ON CLASS ATTENDANCE

Students are expected to attend the classes on the very first day of each academic year. Attendance of over 75% is mandatory for all the students. Students are further required to attend lectures, laboratory (Practical's), tutorials, dissections, field visits, clinics and other scheduled activities including periodical tests regularly. Eligibility for examinations is determined by satisfactory attendance and performance. Students with an unsatisfactory attendance record of less than 75% are not eligible to appear in examination. If a student remains absent without any reason or permission he / she shall be liable for disciplinary action along with a financial penalty.

DISCIPLINE

The institutional Discipline remains as the prime importance and the high quality behavior and the students attitudes shall have to be continuously observed. Use of unfair means during examination as well as in other evaluation system shall not be permissible & may result in misconduct & irrevocable dismissal from the college. Any student found in any illegal activity shall be punished by the Administration on the recommendation of Disciplinary Committee. This cannot be challenged in any court of law.

OTHER REASONS OF DISMISSAL

1. Submission of false documentation.
2. Embezzlement
3. Willful damage of equipments, furniture, fixtures, property & intentional breakage of glassware in laboratories shall be liable for Deduction from Security Deposit.
4. Physical violence against other students, faculty or staff.
5. Use of drugs, Narcotics & Smoking is strictly prohibited.
6. Nonpayment of tuition and other fees within the specified period.
7. Continuous absence from classes without any valid reason and permission.

ORGANIZATION OF SEMESTER SYSTEM

ATTENDANCE OF THE STUDENTS

The University is determined to improve its teaching standards. The record of attendance is essential to determine eligibility of students for her/his appearing in the examination.

- * 75% attendance is mandatory to be eligible to appear in the semester examination.
- * 10% waiver (5% by Vice Chancellor & 5% by waiver committee) can be given on medical grounds or any other valid reason acceptable by the committee.
- * Less than 65% attendance shall not be eligible to appear in the regular semester examination.
- * At least 40% attendance shall be eligible to appear in the RE-SIT EXAMINATION only.

FIRST AND SECOND SEMESTER EXAMINATION

First semester students who after appearing in regular semester examination, either declared pass or fail will be allowed for promotion to the second semester.

Upon promoting to 2nd semester students who either PASS or FAIL, in first semester examination, both will be allowed to appear in 2nd semester (Regular) examination and pending result of second semester examination. If the classes of 3rd semester are commences, students of 2nd semester (either PASS or FAIL in 1st semester) will be allowed to attend the class of 3rd semester.

After announcement of 2nd semester examination result, students of 1st and 2nd semester will fall in the following groups.

- a. Passed First and Second Semester.
- b. Passed Second Semester but failed in First Semester.
- c. Passed First Semester but failed in Second Semester.
- d. Failed in both Semester.

Students under category “B”, “C” and “D” will be allowed Re-sit examination of First and Second Semesters simultaneously while they remain under study process of Third Semester. After announcement of Re-sit examinations result of both First & Second Semesters, the students will be bifurcated into the following groups:

- 1) Passed First and Second Semester examinations completely, they will continue in 3rd semester.
- 2) Students who failed either in First Semester or in Second Semester or both examinations shall be reverted i.e. **TERM BACK** to First Semester or in Second Semester or both with junior batch.

NOTE: In case of their failure in subjects of 1st Semester or 2nd Semester or both semesters, after re-sit/repeat examination, 8 (eight) chances/whether appear or not despite being eligible for each examination shall cease to purpose further DPT education. Their names shall be struck off from the roll of Al-Biruni Institute of Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation Sciences affiliated with Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences, Jamshoro as per policy of this University.

THIRD AND FOURTH SEMESTER EXAMINATION

Third Semester students who after appearing in Third Semester (Regular) examinations, either declared PASS or FAIL will be allowed in Fourth Semester, upon promotion in 4th Semester students who either have passed or fail in 3 semester examination.

Pending result of 4th semester examination, if the classes of 5th semester are commenced, students of 4th semester (either pass or fail in 3rd semester) will be allowed to attend the classes of 5th semester. After announcement of 4th semester examination result, students of 3rd and 4th semester will fall in the following groups.

- a. Passed 3rd and 4th semester.
- b. Passed 4th semester but failed in 3rd semester.
- c. Passed 3rd semester but failed in 4th semester.
- d. Failed in both the semester.

Students under category B, C and D will be allowed Re-sit examination of 3rd and 4th semesters simultaneously, while they remain under study process of 5th semester.

After announcement of Re-sit examinations result of both 3rd and 4th semesters, the students will be bifurcated into the following group:

1. Passed 3rd and 4th semesters examination completely, they will continue in 5th semester.
2. Students who failed either in 3rd semester or in 4th semester or both examination shall be reverted i.e. **TERM BACK** to 3rd semester or in 4th semester or both with junior batch.

NOTE: Above group of students of Physical Therapy, after term back, will repeat the failure subject(s) of semester 3rd or 4th or both with junior batch.

FIFTH AND SIXTH SEMESTER EXAMINATION

5th semester students who after appearing in 5th semester (regular) examination, either declare PASS or FAIL will be allowed promotion to 6th semester.

Upon promotion in 6th semester, students who either PASS or FAIL in 5th semester examination both will be allowed to appear in 6th semester examination.

Pending result of 6th semester examination, if the classes for 7th semester are commenced, students of 6th semester (either pass or fail in 5th semester) will be allowed to attend the classes of 7th semester. After announcement of 6th semester examination result, students of 5th and 6th semesters will fall in the following groups:

- a. Passed 5th and 6th semester.
- b. Passed 6th semester but failed in 5th semester.
- c. Passed 5th semester but failed in 6th semester.
- d. Failed in both the semester.

Students under category B,C and D will be allowed Re-sit examination of 5th and 6th semesters simultaneously, while they remain under study process of 7th semester.

After announcement of Re-sit examinations result of both 5th and 6th semesters, the students will be bifurcated into the following groups:

1. Passed 5th and 6th semesters examination completely, they will continue in 7th semester.
2. Students who failed either in 5th semester or in 6th semester or both examination shall be reverted i.e.

TERM BACK to 5th semester or in 6th semester or both with junior batch.

SEVENTH AND EIGHT SEMESTER EXAMINATION

7th Semester Students who after appearing in 7th Semester (Regular) examination, either declare PASS OR FAIL will be allowed promotion to 8th Semester.

Upon promotion in in 8th semester, students who either PASS or FAIL in 7th semester examination both will be allowed to appear in 8th semester examination.

Pending result of 7th semester examination, if the classes for 9th semester are commenced, students of 8th semester (either pass or fail in 7th semester) will be allowed to attend the classed of 9th semester. After announcement of 8th semester examination result, students of 7th and 8th semester will fail in the following groups:

- a. Passed 7th and 8th semester.
- b. Passed 8th semester but failed in and 7th semester.
- c. Passed 7th semester but failed in and 8th semester.
- d. Failed in both the semester.

Students under category B,C and D will be allowed re-sit examination of 7th semester simultaneously, while they remain under study process of 9th semester.

After announcement of Re-sit examination result of both 7th and 8th semesters, the students will be bifurcated into the following groups:

1. Passed 7th and 8th semesters examination completely, they will continue in 9th semester.
2. Students who failed either in 7th semester or in 8th semester or both examination shall be reverted i.e.

TERM BACK to 7th semester or in 8th semester or both with junior batch.

IMPORTANT

Above group of students of BS Nursing after **TERM BACK** will repeat the failure subject(s) of 7th or 8th semesters both with junior batch.

NINTH AND TENTH SEMESTER EXAMINATION

9th semester students who after appearing in 9th semester (regular) examination, either declared PASS or FAIL will be allowed promotion to 10th semester.

Upon promotion in 10th semester students who have either passed or failed in 9th semester examination both will be allowed to appear in 10th semester examination.

1. In case, students who will be declared pass both in 9th and 10th semesters, they will be declared to have pass DPT Examination completely and shall be awarded degree.
2. However, in case of failure in either 9th and 10th or both semesters they will be allowed to appear in Re-sit examination and will continue to repeat failure subject(s) till they completely pass the 9th/10th or both semester Examinations.

FEE FOR FAILURE / REPEATER STUDENTS

In case of students who are admitted under semester system and are declared fail in one semester but passed the other semester of the same year, they will be charged HALF SELF-FINANCE FEE.

In case of detained / with-held students shall be charged **ONE THIRD (1/3)** of the Total Amount Tuition Fee (for each failed subject), if a student is failed in all subjects 75% of annual tuition fee shall be charged. Repeater candidates who are admitted under general regular merit category will be charged FULL FEE.

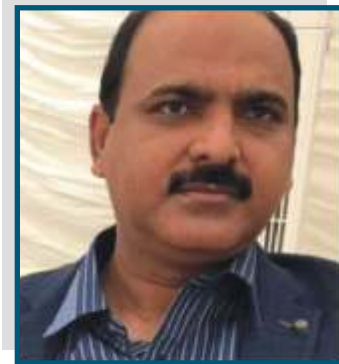

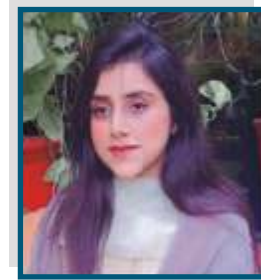
